Hello. My name's Bob Forder.

I'd like to begin by explaining who I am, what I plan

I have been a member of the NSS for very many years, more recently have joined

0:01:07.570,0:01:15.310 My great-grandfather, also Robert Forder, was a poor man from Norfolk who joined the

campaigns of the third quarter of the 19th century and, like many other,s he

0:01:43.000,0:01:51.380 Bradlaugh founded the National Secular Society in 1866 and became its first president.

0:01:56.500,0:02:03.480 by 1877 the Society had grown sufficiently to employ a paid secretary.

0:02:07.229,0:02:12.130 whose administrative skills and loyalty for Bradlaugh, had earned him the

0:02:12.130,0:02:18.470 president's trust. Robert remained secretary until 1891 and

0:02:18.470,0:02:24.830 was therefore associated with all Bradlaugh's struggles, which I shall endeavour

0:02:24.830,0:02:32.840 to explore in subsequent talks. He also became a publisher in his own right,

Over the years I've collected a large

many directly relevant the career of

0:02:50.920,0:02:57.690 Charles Bradlaugh and the NSS. It's been a jolly good area for collecting.

The books are scarce,
but often remarkably cheap because most

To be honest, at first I didn't always understand their significance or

importance in the eyes of the radicals of the period.

But as time has gone on, and I've read more widely, I think I've come to

Having spent a career teaching humanities subjects, and particularly history, I've

also come to understand that history means different things to different people.

And it's teaching serves different purposes according to who you speak to.

On the one hand there is the history of

what you might loosely term conservative traditionalists, even nationalists.

Their history dwells on topics such as 1066, the fleet that beat the Spanish Armada,

All these important topics appear on the

the direction of the trade union movement and Peterloo, for example, but I

ask you: What is the overall message of school history for the student?

contained within books and journals with generally short print runs.

ordinary

people, revolt, rebellion, protest and

The NSS and its history is a small part of this alternative history, but it is
