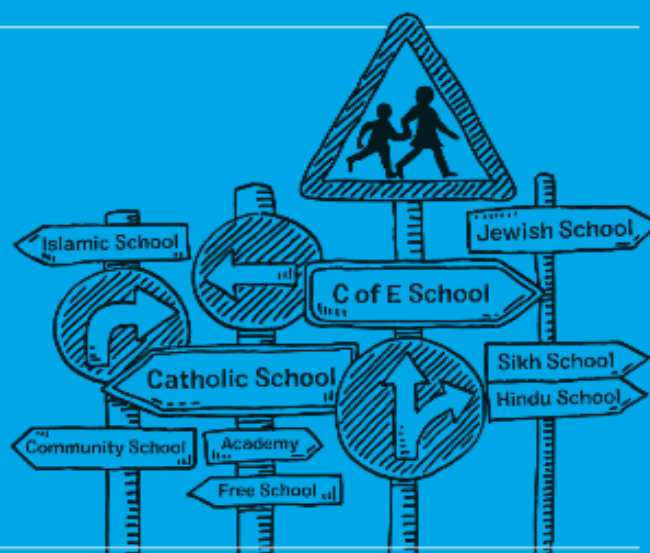


2021 Local authority scorecard

How faith schools restrict choice in England



The local authority scorecard provides information on how faith schools restrict families' choice and access to a secular education across England.

1. School options

This measure looks at the proportion of postcodes in a local authority where the option of a local non-faith school is restricted to various extents. This measure looks at the three nearest schools.

By this measure, the local authority is the 11th worst performing in England.

By this measure, the local authority is the 12th worst performing in England.

2. School options

This measure is the same as above. But it does not count all three nearest schools if the second or third requires more than a mile of additional travel from the closest.

5. Notes

- A. Measures 1, 2 and 3 based on analysis of data from the Get information about schools service open as of download in June 2021.
- B. Measures 1 and 2 looked at 486,177 postcodes across all local authorities in England.
- C. Measure 4 based on analysis of freedom of information request for September 2021 entry.
- D. Ranking in measure 4 is based on % of total applicants with preferences expressed.
- E. For pupils assigned faith schools against their wishes, FoI response used local authority #888 - Lancashire - see also Blackburn with Darwen and Blackpool
- F. 4 Grammar schools are included in Lancashire. Not all pupils will have access to these schools, meaning that non-faith school options may actually be more restricted.
- G. Password for protected sheets is "2021" making changes may stop the scorecard working.
