

Islamic charities promoting extremist and harmful material on their websites

Compiled by the National Secular Society

In April we discovered three Islamic charities that run mosques, IslamBradford, Bolton Central Islamic Society and The Preston Muslim Cultural Centre, had links to extremist content on their websites. We informed the Charity Commission for England and Wales, who acknowledged our concerns and said they would be engaging with these charities.

We suspect the problem of Islamic charities signposting extremist material on their websites extends considerably further than these three charities. There are 1935 charities registered in England and Wales that list “religious activities” in their categories and mention “Islam” in their objects. We examined a sample of 70 of these charities.

Out of these, **we found three charities that were not merely signposting extremist content: there was content that could be considered extremist, or at least harmful, hosted on their websites themselves. Those charities are Islamic Centre Leicester, Thamesdown Islamic Association, and Croydon Mosque and Islamic Centre.**

Additionally, we found one charity, The Slough Islamic Trust, linking to extremist content via its website.

At the very least, a charity that is supposed to be serving a public benefit should under no circumstances be promoting these ideas. These are our findings.

“All the schools of thought agree that a person’s apostasy must be proven by the testimony of two male witnesses. **Furthermore, all agree that the apostate’s punishment is death.**

The Hanafis state that he will first be offered a re-invitation to Islam. If he has left Islam because of doubt then the Imam will try to remove his objections and queries. He will be imprisoned for three days, to give him time to reconsider his decision. Imam Shafi adds that it is forbidden to kill the apostate before this period of three days. During this time, he will be given food and drink regularly; this will come from his own money. If he does not have enough money then the food will be paid for by the Bayt al-Mal (Islamic central fund). He is not punished or tortured during this three-day period.

If the apostate still refuses to revert, then he is killed.”

Question:

Is there a punishment for Muslims who leave the fold of Islam? If so, what is it?

Answer:

Before answering the question on a person who leaves the fold of Islam, it is imperative to note that such punishments are only applicable by a Muslim Judge in a Muslim country, where Shariah law is implemented. The punishments and rulings cannot be enforced otherwise.

A Muslim who leaves the fold of Islam is called a Murtadd.

There are several verses in the Holy Qur'an which state that such a person subjects himself to the wrath of Allah. For example,

-Verily those who disbelieve after their (profession of) belief, and afterward grow violent in disbelief: their repentance will not be accepted. And such are those who are astray (3:90).

-Whoever disbelieves in Allah after his belief - except him who is forced thereto and whose heart is still content with the Faith - but whoever finds ease in disbelief: On them is wrath from Allah. Theirs will be an awful doom.

-Verily those who believe, then disbelieve and then (again) believe, then disbelieve, and then increase in disbelief, Allah will never pardon them, nor will He guide them unto a way. (4; 137).

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If the apostate still refuses to revert, then he is killed.

Question:

I heard other day in Islamic TV programe that TWO types of women never will get the pardon of ALLAH.

The women who are a leader's(in many ways,in politics, at home, at work etc..) and the womens who going to pray at Masjid's.

It was a big surprise for me. Can you help me in this questions? Are any Hadith about this matter?

Answer:

The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) did in fact warn against women taking up political posts. In a Hadith recorded by Imam Bukhari (Book of Expeditions, Chapter; the writing of the Prophet to Kisra, 4073), the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) was informed that a woman had become the leader of Faars, he remarked, 'A community whose affairs are led by a woman will never find success.'

The reason is because it is likely to conflict with other personal and marital duties they hold, and because due to biological reasons (pregnancy, menstrual periods etc.) they would not be able to fulfil their duties at all times. It is for this reason that women are not allowed to lead the prayers, and why no prophet has ever been female.

As for the issue of women coming to the mosque, if the mosque has separate arrangements for men and women, and there is no chance of free-mixing, then it is permissible for them to perform 5 times daily Salah at the mosque, though disliked. It is not compulsory for them to attend though; for example, Juma prayers is not compulsory upon women.

It is said that young women are not permitted to attend the mosques, when there is a chance of discord and free-mixing. In the time of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), women did attend the mosque for congregational prayers, and this was stopped in the time of Umar (may Allah be pleased with me). When women complained to Aisha (may Allah be pleased with her) about this, she replied that if the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) saw the circumstances today, he too would have prevented it.

Overall, the Hanafi position is that she can attend the mosque for 5 times congregational prayers, but it is disliked. A woman's best prayer is conducted in the home.

This page promotes the killing of apostates and other 'unbelievers'

"The third case concerns whether, when someone intentionally calls the Prophet a liar in what he said or brought or denies and rejects his prophethood or his message and its existence or disbelieves in it, he has, by saying this, moved to a different deen.

The consensus is that this person is an unbeliever and must be killed. Then one looks to see whether what he said constitutes a clear statement, in which case the judgement is the same as that for apostasy. There is strong disagreement about whether he is asked to repent or not."

According to another position, his repentance would not in any case prevent his execution because of what is due to the Prophet, if he in fact disparaged him in his lies.

If he conceals what he said, he is judged as a heretic (zindiq). Repentance does not prevent his being executed according to the Malikis as we will clarify. Abu Hanifa and his companions said that it is lawful to kill anyone who declares himself free of Muhammad or calls him a liar. He is an apostate unless he retracts that.

Ibn al-Qasim said that if a Muslim says that Muhammad is not a Prophet or was not sent or that the Qur'an was not revealed to him, he is killed for being a liar. Any Muslim who disbelieves in the Messenger of Allah has the status of an apostate. It is the same with someone who openly declares that he denies the Prophet. He is like an apostate and is called upon to repent. Ibn al-Qasim said something similar about anyone who calls himself a Prophet and says that he has received revelation.

Sahnun and Ibn al-Qasim said that that is the same whether he makes that claim secretly or openly. Asbagh said that he is the same as an apostate because he has rejected the Book of Allah by forging lies against Allah.

Ashab said that any Jew who calls himself a Prophet, claims that he has been sent to people or says that there is a Prophet after our Prophet is asked to repent if he openly declares that. If he repents, he is left. If not, he is killed. This is because he rejects the Prophet who said, "There is no Prophet after me." Therefore he forges lies against Allah in making his claim to the messengership and prophethood.

Muhammad ibn Sahnun said, "Anyone who doubts a single letter which Muhammad, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, brought, is a denying unbeliever."

He said that the judgement against anyone who rejects the Prophet is that he is killed.

Ahmad ibn Sulayman, Sahnun's companion, said that whoever says that the Prophet was black is killed. The Prophet was not black.

Abu 'Uthman al-Haddad said something similar and said that if someone said that the Prophet died before his beard began to grow or that he was in Tahart (Morocco) and not Tihama, he is killed because this constitutes denial.

Habib ibn ar-Rabi' said that it is disbelief to alter his description and its details. The one who does that openly is an unbeliever. He is asked to repent. The one who conceals it is a heretic and is killed without being asked to repent."



We examined one of these books, *Kitabun Nikah* by Hadrat Maulana Muhammad Ibrahim & Palampuri Sahab, which has some extremely misogynistic content:

1. Promotion of marital rape:

P. 47: "The conjugal act is the right of the husband and the woman cannot deny him this right without any valid reason, as there is a strong likelihood of his going astray and resorting to immoral practices for his sexual satisfaction. The same is the right of the woman also."

APPROPRIATE TIME

Generally speaking, sexual intercourse is desirable when the passions of the husband and the wife are high. It is the duty of the wife to win her husband's mind by submitting to his sexual desire. Rasûlullâh ﷺ once said: "Whoever sees a woman, who appears appealing to him, let him go to his wife, because there is with his wife the like of what is with her." Abu Hurairah رضي الله عنه reported that Rasûlullâh ﷺ said: "If a man invites his wife to bed and she does not come, and the husband spends the night angry with her, the angels curse her till the morning." The conjugal act is the right of the husband and the woman cannot deny him this right without any valid reason, as there is a strong likelihood of his going astray and resorting to immoral practices for his sexual satisfaction. The same is the right of the woman also.

P. 62 "Rasulullah said: "When a man calls his wife to fulfill his desires, she should come to him although she may be near a stove (cooking)."... The wife should be obedient to her husband in all respects and administer his comforts even by cutting short her optional religious duties."

DUTIES OF THE WIFE TOWARDS THE HUSBAND

Rasûlullâh ﷺ left the most ideal instruction about duties of the wife towards the husband. The wife is bound to live with her husband. The Holy Qur'ân says: "Your wives are your 'farms', so go to your 'farms' however you like." Rasûlullâh ﷺ said: "When a man calls his wife to fulfill his desire, she should come to him although she may be near a stove (cooking)." This indicates that if the husband has a desire for intercourse, it is permissible during the daytime as well. Rasûlullâh ﷺ also said: "Whenever a man calls his wife to fulfill his desire and she refuses and he passes the night in an angry mood, the angels curse her till she gets up at dawn."

1. Promotion of wife beating:

P. 59: "The husband should not beat his wife; this creates bitter feelings and is suicidal to domestic peace and happiness. In some extreme cases, mild hitting is allowed, but not on the face."

The husband should not beat his wife; this creates bitter feelings and is suicidal to domestic peace and happiness. In some extreme cases, mild hitting is allowed, but not on the face. It should never be inflicted in such a way so as to injure her. The Holy Qur'ân prescribes some preliminary steps before hitting; namely, admonishment and separation from the bed. Rasûlullâh ﷺ discouraged hitting by saying: "The best of you is he who is the best to his wife." He further said: "Never hit your partner like

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2. Promotion of female subordination and sexist stereotypes

P. 61: "Allah has blessed the males with many qualities which are found less among females. Bravery, courage, honour and authority are found in a complete form among males. It is for this reason that Allah has granted the males authority over females. It is there responsibility of the husband to keep in check the character of the wife. The husband should immediately caution the wife if he finds the wife freely mixing and conversing with the servants of the house or other strangers."

CHARACTER

Allâh has blessed the males with many qualities which are found less among females. Bravery, courage, honour and authority are found in a complete form among males. It is for this reason that Allâh has granted the males authority over females. It is the responsibility of the husband to keep in check the character of the wife. The husband should immediately caution the wife if he finds the wife freely mixing and conversing with the servants of the house or other strangers. It is easier to prohibit the wife initially than to maintain silence at the time of the incident and allow it to become more serious later on. If the husband condones this conduct of the wife of mixing with strangers, then he is a cuckold (*dayyûth*) and he has been cursed in the Ahâdîth. The wife is a very valuable asset and should be carefully safeguarded. One should not allow people to come in and out of one's house unnecessarily.

P.63: "The wife should not leave the house without the prior permission of the husband"

It is clear that there will come a time, when women will encounter certain conditions, which will require them to leave their homes. In light of this, Islamic rulings have been revealed through the Holy Qur’an and Sunnah that stipulate the requirements of covering for women outside of the house. It is established that when leaving the home, women should cover everything from their head to their feet. No part of the body must be visible: ‘O Prophet! Tell your wives and your daughters and the believing women to draw their veils (جلباب) (Jalbab over their body.’ (s33, v59) Sayyidina Abdullah Ibn Abbas relates: ‘جلباب refers to that piece of clothing, that if a woman was to adorn it, it would hide everything from her head to her feet. The head covering should hide from her face down to below her chest. Only the eyes should be left, so as to see the way.’ (Tafsir Ibn Jarir, vol 22, p29/ Tafsir Ibn Abbas/ Ma’ariful Qur’an, vol 7, p217/))”

“It is sad indeed, in this age, after receiving so much of the bounties of Allah , the Muslim women regard it as fashion and honour to display their bodies and beautify themselves for all of the creation to see. Just like Salah and Saum, it is compulsory (Fard) for a woman to cover herself in the manner Islam has stipulated when leaving the house. It is unanimous amongst the Scholars and Jurists (Fuqaha) of the Ummah that this method of covering is permissible when a woman leaves her home for a necessity. In the Sahih Ahadith, the above mentioned mode of covering is permitted bearing in mind the following main restrictions among others are observed: (1) permission from her husband must be obtained (2) the burqa’ or cloth wrapping should not be decorated or attractive (3) she should Not use perfume (4) she should not wear shoes or jewellery that makes a sound whilst walking (5) she should refrain from raising her voice unnecessarily when out in public (6) she should keep away from groups of men in the streets etc.”

In Islam, it is considered a great sin (Haram) for a woman to be unveiled in front of strange (non-mahram) men. It is not a cause of amazement; as in Christianity, it is ordered that a woman who roams with her hair uncovered should have her hair shaved off-1 Corinthians 11:6: ‘In fact, a woman who will not wear a veil ought to have her hair cut off. If a woman is ashamed to have her hair cut off or shaved, she ought to wear a veil.’

It is merely ignorance and propaganda against the religion of Islam to claim its orders oppress and subjugate its womenfolk. This is merely a religion of peace and modesty, completing the teachings of all previous Prophets عليهم السلام and the revealed scriptures.

Sayyidina Anas ؓ relates: The Prophet ﷺ stated: ‘Allah ﷻ curses the one who looks at and the one who shows their private part to others.’ (Mishkaat Masabih, vol 1, p467)

The Shari’ah has safeguarded the modesty and honour of women by ordaining the rules of covering. There are 3 levels for the covering of women:

1. **That a women stays inside her home:** This is the highest form of ‘covering’ stipulated in Islam, through the verses of the Holy Qur’an. The Holy Qur’an states that a woman should not leave her home without a valid Shari’ah reason. ‘And stay in your houses, and do not display yourselves like the women of the time of ignorance.’ (s33,v33)

Sayyidina Ibn Masud ؓ relates: The Prophet ﷺ said: ‘When a woman leaves her house, Shaytaan (the devil) utilises her presence to spread evil.’ (Jami Tirmidhi)

The Prophet ﷺ said: ‘A woman is closest to her Creator when she is in the inner confines of her home.’ (Ibn Khuzaimah/ Sahih Ibn Hibban)

The Prophet ﷺ said: 'There is no place for a woman to leave her home, except if there is a dire necessity for her to fulfill.' (Tibrani/ Kanzul Amar, vol 8, p263)

Sayyidina Ali رضي الله عنه relates: 'One day I was in the company of the Prophet ﷺ wherein the Prophet ﷺ asked the Companions رضي الله عنهم: 'What is best for a woman?' All the Companions رضي الله عنهم remained silent. When I returned home, I asked this same question of Fatima رضي الله عنها. She رضي الله عنها replied: 'It is best for a woman that she not look at any man and no man should look upon her.' I (Ali) then repeated this response of Fatima رضي الله عنها to the Prophet ﷺ. He ﷺ said: 'She has spoken the truth, verily she is a part of me.' (Ma'ariful Qur'an, vol 7, p216)

For this reason, the Mothers of the Faithful (wives of the Prophet ﷺ, daughters of the Prophet ﷺ and the women folk of the pious predecessors would consider it unpleasant to leave their homes without a dire necessity. The Prophet ﷺ is the greatest example for Mankind to follow, likewise the womenfolk of the Prophet's ﷺ household are the greatest example for believing women to follow.

2. **To adorn a Burqa (برقع) thick long cloth when leaving the house:** The religion of Islam is a complete all encompassing teaching, wherein all the requirements of the creation have been catered for and considered. It is clear that there will come a time, when women will encounter certain conditions, which will require them to leave their homes. In light of this, Islamic rulings have been revealed through the Holy Qur'an and Sunnah that stipulate the requirements of covering for women outside of the house. It is established that when leaving the home, women should cover everything from their head to their feet. No part of the body must be visible: 'O Prophet! Tell your wives and your daughters and the believing women to draw their veils (جلباب) Jalbab over their body.' (s33, v59)

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The clothing referred to as (برقع) Burqa' and (حجاب) Hijab is included within the term (جلباب) Jalbab and falls within the same ruling of covering according to the Holy Qur'an.

Sayyidah Aisha رضي الله عنها stated: 'Allah ﷻ have mercy on these women, those who migrated (from Makkah to Madinah) in the beginning of Islam. And when the order of Allah ﷻ came for women to cover, they cut their thick sheets and covered their whole bodies with them.' (Sunan Abu Dawood #702)

The Covering of the Face According To the 4 Great Scholars

Imam Malik, Imam Shafi and Imam Ahmed bin Hanbal رحمهم الله all state, whether there is fear of Fitnah (danger of evil) or not, it is not permissible for a woman to uncover her face or hands (except fingers).

Imam Azam Abu Hanifa رحمه الله, whilst keeping in mind a narration of Ibn Abbas رضي الله عنه stated: 'It is permissible to uncover the face when there is no danger of Fitnah.' Nowadays, the eradication of Fitnah is not practical. For this reason, the jurists of the Hanifi School, like the scholars of the other 3 schools, have ruled it impermissible for a woman to display her face to a non-mahram. Therefore, the scholars of all 4 schools of thought are unanimous upon the covering of the face in all conditions.

Allamah Abideen Shami رحمه الله writes: 'The permissibility of a man seeing the face of a strange women is dependant upon there being no desire involved. If the condition of 'no desire' is not able to be upheld, then it is Haram for a man to gaze upon a strange women. This quality (no desire with the gaze) was only found in the first 3 generations of Islam, in our time it is absolutely prohibited, due to the presence of wide spread fitnah, except for a valid Shari'ee reason. For example: 'for a judge to verify the witnessing of a woman.' (Radul Mukhtaar, Kitabul Qarahiya)

For a young mature woman, according to the ruling of Shari'ah, it is necessary for her to cover her face in all conditions when leaving the house. This is due to the possibility of impermissible glances she will receive from the opposite sex. There are many rulings of this type found in the Shari'ah; for example: In a journey, due to the usual presence of difficulty the traveller is ordered to pray Qasr Salah, allowing them to shorten their prayers. If one experiences a more comfortable state in a journey than at home, even then Qasr Salah has to be observed. In the same way, in the state of sleep, a person could release air and usually be unaware of it. For this reason, the Shari'ah has ruled that the state of sleep (whilst reclining) itself causes a persons Wudhu to break and orders that a fresh Wudhu (ablution) be performed upon waking prior to any worship. For this reason, the jurists of the Hanifi school, like the scholars of the other 3 schools, have ruled it impermissible for a woman to display her face in public, regardless of the presence of Fitnah or not.

In conclusion, aside from the Holy Qur'an and Sahih Ahadith, the very actions of the common women Companions (Sahabiyaat رضي الله عنهن) of the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم was to cover the face and entire body when outside the house. It has also been proven that this is the required state for women, even in the state of Ihraam, as proven from Sahih Ahadith.

Those women who are passing their lives in a manner of being unveiled in every day life, should reflect and be modest and mindful of Allah عز وجل. They should pay special attention to 3 things: (1) to repent with true regret of not dressing in the manner of Islam and seek to adopt the correct manners of clothing for women in Islam (2) should be mindful of giving account of their actions to Allah عز وجل on the Day of Judgement and the warnings and punishments for not being properly covered in the Qur'an and Ahadith (3) wherever and whenever women encounter other women who have adopted the correct manner of dress according to Islam, they should treat each other with great respect and dignity.

We pray that Allah عز وجل grant us the ability to adopt the teachings of this pure religion, following the way of those who earned the pleasure of Allah عز وجل through doing so, Ameen.
