Lists as a concern:

- “The new subjects intend to promote and normalise same-sex relationships”

Examples of content which “disregards traditional and religious values adhered to by the many”:

- Children accepting that families “sometimes look different from their family, but that they should respect those differences and know that other children’s families are characterised by love and care for them.”
- Understanding that marriage (including same-sex marriage) is “a formal and legally recognised commitment of two people to each other which is intended to be lifelong.”

At secondary level complain that:

- “Without any parental knowledge or consent, child(ren) will be given information and advice on contraceptives and abortion services. Abortion is offered to children as an option during pregnancy.”

- “We have not been contacted directly or indirectly by those involved in the Parkfield protests. Also at no point have we initiated any contact with those involved with any protests, including Parkfield, nor do we intend to do so in the future. We advise parents to work collaboratively with schools to ensure their child(ren)’s wellbeing and innocence are protected. We do not have any official letters for parents, however we do advise them to exercise their parental right to withdraw their child(ren), should they wish to do so. All of our official documents carry our organisation’s details.”

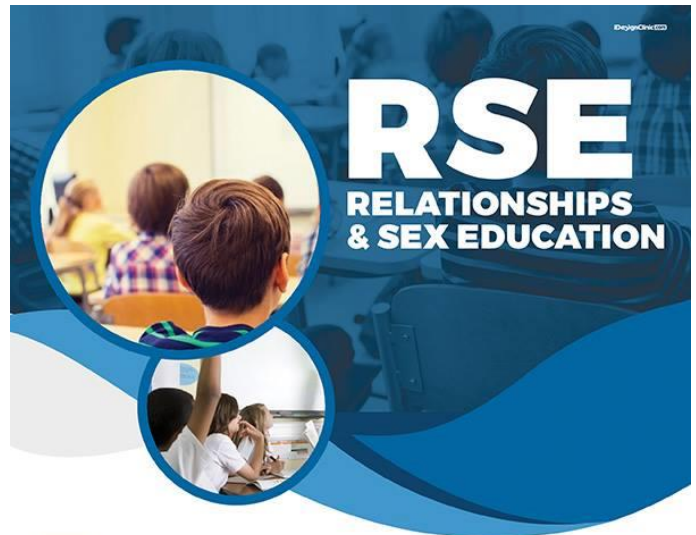
