Ep 16: Operation Christmas Child | Faith schools

0:00:07.220,0:00:11.389 and this week i'll be talking to Alastair Lichten, the NSS's education

0:00:11.389,0:00:15.950 officer and Megan Manson, the campaign's officer. In the first half of this

0:00:15.950,0:00:18.770 podcast we'll be looking at Operation Christmas Child

0:00:18.770,0:00:23.300 and how a seemingly innocuous appeal to send toys to developing countries is

0:00:23.300,0:00:28.460 being exploited by Christian evangelists. Later in the show I'll be speaking to

0:00:28.460,0:00:31.970 Alistair about why twenty thousand primary and secondary school children

0:00:31.970,0:00:38.400 are being sent to faith schools despite their parents preferring non faith schools.

0:00:39.980,0:00:45.640 Do you remember filling shoeboxes with toys when you were at school, to be sent to

0:00:45.650,0:00:50.390 children in developing countries. I certainly do. Many schools, youth groups

0:00:50.390,0:00:53.780 and others have been taking part in this well-meaning practice for years at 0:00:53.780,0:00:58.130 Christmastime. But did you know that the organization behind Operation Christmas

0:00:58.130,0:01:02.820 Child is an evangelical Christian charity called Samaritan's Purse?

0:01:02.820,0:01:07.840 This organization seems to be using the shoeboxes as, in effect, a bribe to

0:01:07.850,0:01:12.620 persuade children to attend it's religious program. as their website puts

0:01:12.620,0:01:17.360 it "after receiving a shoebox gift, children have the opportunity to enroll

0:01:17.360,0:01:22.520 in The Greatest Journey - 12 fun and interactive Bible lessons where they get

0:01:22.520,0:01:26.990 the chance to discover who Jesus is and how to begin their own journey of faith.

0:01:26.990,0:01:31.870
The website also states that operating with "communities in needs" in

0:01:31.870,0:01:35.150 Sub-Saharan Africa, Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

0:01:35.150,0:01:39.600 Samaritan's Purse describes itself in its mission statement as

"a non-denominational evangelical Christian organization that helps to meet needs of

0:01:45.260,0:01:49.490

people who are victims of war, poverty, natural disasters, disease, and famine

0:01:49.490,0:01:55.100 with the purpose of sharing God's love through His Son, Jesus Christ.

0:01:55.100,0:02:00.350 In other words, as with many religious charities laudable motives of

0:02:00.350,0:02:03.710 helping people in distress are mingled with the more problematic

0:02:03.710,0:02:08.240 aim of proselytizing and converting people to the version of Christianity

0:02:08.240,0:02:12.990 which they espouse. And in the case of Samaritan's Purse,

0:02:12.990,0:02:18.960 this seems to be a fairly dogmatic, if not fundamentalist, version. The statement

0:02:18.960,0:02:22.920 of faith on the charity's website asserts among other things in the same

0:02:22.920,0:02:28.320 vein that "We believe that, for the salvation of lost and sinful man,

0:02:28.320,0:02:33.000 repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ result in regeneration by the

0:02:33.000,0:02:38.870 Holy Spirit and that Jesus Christ is the only way of salvation."

0:02:38.870,0:02:42.270 Under current English law Samaritan's Purse

0:02:42.270,0:02:46.650 is entitled to have charitable status, with the concomitant tax relief and

0:02:46.650,0:02:52.530 other benefits that this brings. This is because the "advancement of religion" is a

0:02:52.530,0:02:58.340 recognized charitable purpose. In the 21st century, in a society in which

0:02:58.340,0:03:03.320 around half of the population is non-religious, is this situation justifiable?

0:03:03.320,0:03:08.640 I'm joined now by Megan Manson and Alistair Lichten to discuss these issues further.

0:03:08.640,0:03:13.980 Megan and Alistair, hello. Megan first, are the schools and

0:03:13.980,0:03:18.810 other organizations who send shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child aware of

0:03:18.810,0:03:21.540 the evangelical purpose for which they're being used?

0:03:21.540,0:03:23.360 (Megan Manson) Not necessarily .

0:03:23.370,0:03:28.560 Operation Christmas Child has grown more transparent about what they do and their

0:03:28.560,0:03:33.090 website actually explains it in quite a lot of detail. But, of course, the thing is

0:03:33.090,0:03:37.350 not everyone who participates in the scheme reads the website or read their

0:03:37.350,0:03:42.870 leaflets. In the cases of schools, parents simply find out that they have to help

0:03:42.870,0:03:47.100 their child fill a box of toys and that box will go to children in an 0:03:47.100,0:03:51.680 impoverished country. and they'll understandably take that at face value,

0:03:51.680,0:03:56.520 as on the surface it seems like a nice thing to do and a good way to teach

0:03:56.520,0:04:00.960 children about the importance of generosity and civil responsibility.

0:04:00.960,0:04:05.430 Few of those parents are going to think to question it. They probably wouldn't

0:04:05.430,0:04:10.280 even imagine that those toys will be used as part of a religious missionary scheme.

0:04:10.280,0:04:15.300 (EP) What are the National Secular Society's objections to the scheme?

0:04:15.300,0:04:20.700 (MM) Well, the main objection we have is that it's unethical and exploitative. So primarily

0:04:20.700,0:04:25.410 its exploiting children and families in poor countries by putting them under

0:04:25.410,0:04:29.640 pressure to convert to fundamentalist Christianity. It's hard to say no to

0:04:29.640,0:04:34.830 people who come bearing gifts, especially for one's children. Many critics have

0:04:34.830,0:04:39.660 pointed out that the scheme smacks of colonialism. And it exploits children and

0:04:39.660,0:04:44.610 families in rich countries too. It uses their generosity as a tool for religious conversion.

Once they find out how the shoeboxes are being used, many

0:04:49.080,0:04:53.010 participants are rightly horrified. They never wished to be used as the unwitting

0:04:53.010,0:04:58.650 agents in religious propaganda. And there are other considerations, as well. We have

0:04:58.650,0:05:02.220 to think about the environmental impact of flying tons of plastic toys across

0:05:02.220,0:05:06.360 the world every year. And then there's the potential impacts on the local economy.

How are local vendors trying to sell their own products supposed to

0:05:10.170,0:05:14.550 compete with a multi-million pound scheme with this aggressive agenda and

0:05:14.550,0:05:19.260 these free handouts. And then, finally, there's the ineffectiveness of it all.

0:05:19.260,0:05:23.730 Filling shoeboxes with plastic trinkets to send overseas is a really inefficient

0:05:23.730,0:05:29.060 way to give to charity, monetary donations are far more effective for really helping people.

0:05:29.060,0:05:32.010 (EP) You mentioned on your blog that some religious charities

0:05:32.010,0:05:36.510 are less objectionable, because they follow third sector best practice.

0:05:36.510,0:05:41.500 Could you explain what this means, and how is it that the Samaritan's Purse are failing to follow 0:05:41.500,0:05:45.720 third sector best practice? (MM) Reputable charities providing

0:05:45.720,0:05:49.590 aid in developing countries are well aware and they understand the

0:05:49.590,0:05:53.970 sensitivities involved in such activities. And they work to ensure that

0:05:53.970,0:05:58.950 human rights and dignity is central to their work. For example, equality is a key

0:05:58.950,0:06:03.330 part of this work. Aid must be distributed equally and fairly. But with

0:06:03.330,0:06:07.400 Operation Christmas Child, children get random boxes with different things inside.

0:06:07.400,0:06:10.880 And inevitably some children get more toys or better toys than others,

0:06:10.890,0:06:16.890 which could stir up tension. Many organizations, including international

0:06:16.890,0:06:20.880 aid charities, have expressed their concerns about Operation Christmas Child.

0:06:20.880,0:06:24.840 Brendan Paddy of Save the Children has criticized the scheme and said it is

0:06:24.840,0:06:28.710 dangerous when charities mix humanitarian work with the promotion of

0:06:28.710,0:06:33.270 a particular religious or political agenda. (EP) Does the National Secular Society

0:06:33.270,0:06:37.350 think Operation Christmas Child ought to be abandoned altogether?

0:06:37.350,0:06:41.440 Wouldn't that be a bit harsh on children in developing countries who might be

0:06:41.440,0:06:45.040 looking forward to a Christmas present? (MM) Well, firstly it's worth pointing out

0:06:45.040,0:06:48.180 that many of the communities targeted by Operation Christmas Child

0:06:48.180,0:06:51.360 don't even celebrate Christmas. The charity targets

0:06:51.360,0:06:55.560 majority Muslim areas, which makes sense, because the whole idea of the program is

0:06:55.560,0:07:02.580 to turn non-christians into Christians. When we look at who's behind the

0:07:02.580,0:07:06.840 Samaritan's Purse charity, we can understand just why this is so insidious.

0:07:06.840,0:07:11.400 The president of Samaritan's Purse is American missionary Franklin Graham,

0:07:11.400,0:07:17.360 who is the son of the former notorious televangelist Billy Graham.

0:07:17.360,0:07:21.660
Franklin Graham has some alarming views, including when it comes to Muslims.

0:07:21.660,0:07:25.620 He is supportive of banning Muslims from entering the US, and he has helped

0:07:25.620,0:07:29.760 propagate the conspiracy theory that Barack Obama is a secret Muslim.

0:07:29.760,0:07:34.260

Bearing this in mind, his suitability as a figurehead of aid work in Islamic

0:07:34.260,0:07:37.430 countries is, well, questionable to say the least.

0:07:37.430,0:07:41.550 Samaritan's Purse does do other work, but its resources are dominated by this

0:07:41.550,0:07:47.660 Operation Christmas Child initiative. So let's take a look at its finances.

0:07:47.660,0:07:55.940 It's got an income of over £15.9 million, as of 2018, which means it's one of the richest charities

0:07:55.940,0:08:02.480 in the country. Last year it spent under £400,000 on emergency responses,

0:08:02.480,0:08:06.920 £1.4 Million on long-term development,

0:08:06.920,0:08:11.360 just over £51,000 on other activities,

0:08:11.360,0:08:16.380 over £230,000 on their Greatest Journey indoctrination program,

0:08:16.380,0:08:20.970 and then a whopping £13 Million on Operation Christmas Child.

0:08:20.970,0:08:24.330 In other words, Samaritan's Purse spends far more of its donations on Operation

0:08:24.330,0:08:28.790 Christmas Child, and the related indoctrination programs, than anything else.

0:08:28.790,0:08:33.780 If Samaritan's Purse is serious about genuinely making a positive difference

0:08:33.780,0:08:37.620

to the lives of children in developing countries, it would make sense to ditch

0:08:37.620,0:08:43.240 the Operation Christmas Child Scheme and focus more on aid work with no religious strings attached.

0:08:43.240,0:08:47.500 (EP) What does the National Secular Society propose should be done with the money

0:08:47.500,0:08:52.000 that would otherwise go to the shoeboxes? (MM) Giving to charity is a personal choice

0:08:52.000,0:08:55.540 at the end of the day. So whether or not one should partake in

0:08:55.550,0:09:00.260 a particular charitable activity is entirely up to the individual. The same

0:09:00.260,0:09:04.520 applies to Operation Christmas Child. But we want to make sure that, before parents

0:09:04.520,0:09:08.780 and schools decide to contribute to this project, they are aware of exactly what

0:09:08.780,0:09:13.320 will happen when they take part, so they can make an informed choice.

0:09:13.320,0:09:18.800 We've made a few suggestions on our website about alternative appeals to Operation Christmas Child.

0:09:18.800,0:09:23.320 they include Oxfam Unwrapped and Plan UK Sponsor a Child program.

0:09:23.320,0:09:27.020 We also have information for parents and others whose school, club

0:09:27.020,0:09:30.220

or other organizations are taking part in Operation Christmas Child,

0:09:30.220,0:09:35.660 and what they can do to raise objections. (EP) Now moving on to the wider issue of

0:09:35.660,0:09:40.610 charitable uses of religion, where in the laws of England and Wales does it say

0:09:40.610,0:09:44.500 that advancement of religion is a charitable purpose?

0:09:44.500,0:09:52.100 (MM) So this is all determined by the charity law.

The Charities Act 2011, which lists 13

0:09:52.100,0:09:57.620 different purposes a charity can have. Advancement of religion is one of those.

0:09:57.620,0:10:03.240
This purpose, advancement of religion, has been part of charity law in various forms

0:10:03.240,0:10:07.200 for a very long time, pretty much as long as charities have been around.

0:10:07.200,0:10:11.820 (EP) So is it time to legislate to stop the advancement of religion being

0:10:11.820,0:10:15.080 a charitable purpose? Is it right that Christian and other

0:10:15.080,0:10:19.160 religious organizations should have to pay taxes for the work they do, even if

0:10:19.160,0:10:24.020 it involves helping people in distress? (MM) Well, we think it really is now the time

0:10:24.020,0:10:28.100 to remove the advancements of religion from the list of charitable purposes.

0:10:28.100,0:10:32.560
The many religious charities out there that do provide a genuine public benefit and

0:10:32.560,0:10:36.600 do help people would have no difficulty in registering under a different

0:10:36.860,0:10:41.740 charitable purpose. So, for example, a Christian charity that does overseas aid work

0:10:41.740,0:10:46.100 could list under 'relief of poverty'.
But organizations that exist solely to

0:10:46.100,0:10:51.080 promote religious ideology with no apparent tangible public benefit should

0:10:51.080,0:10:56.480 not be entitled to all the tax breaks and other benefits that charity status confers.

0:10:56.540,0:11:00.200 So, removing the 'advancement of religion' as a charitable purpose would

0:11:00.200,0:11:05.180
ensure all charities are treated equally,
and they're all held to the same high standard,

0:11:05.180,0:11:10.380 regardless of their particular religious ethos. (EP) Alistair do you have anything to add?

0:11:10.440,0:11:13.300 (Alistair Lichten) No. I think that really covers it quite well.

0:11:13.310,0:11:19.550
I just again plug Megan's blog, which will be linked in the show notes

0:11:19.550,0:11:25.130 and the links to the other material that we have. This is the sixth year that

0:11:25.130,0:11:31.940 I've had inquiries

about Operation Christmas Child.

I'll just say, if this is going on in your school, this is an area where I've

0:11:37.310,0:11:43.070 seen schools and organizations which have done Operation Christmas Child, do

0:11:43.070,0:11:49.190 actually respond. It's possible to be constructive on this.

0:11:49.190,0:11:54.180
If your school is committed to doing Operation Christmas Child this year,

0:11:54.180,0:11:59.120 they may not necessarily abandon it this coming year, because they may have made

0:11:59.120,0:12:02.990 the arrangements. But if you bring this information to school's attention and

0:12:02.990,0:12:07.310 actually show the very clear information that's out there, I think a

0:12:07.310,0:12:10.370 lot of schools will just take a look at it and go "actually,

0:12:10.370,0:12:15.110 sorry, we didn't know enough about this. If we want to do some sort

0:12:15.110,0:12:19.400 of charitable thing around Christmas then we'll look into something that's

0:12:19.400,0:12:26.600 more ethical, more effective, more educational." (EP) Megan and Alastair thank you very much.

0:12:26.600,0:12:34.620 (MM) Thank you. (EP) Before we move on to our next topic we wanted

0:12:34.620,0:12:39.760 to share with you a couple of clips from the recent Bradlaugh Lecture 2019, delivered by

0:12:39.760,0:12:44.740 Andrew Moffat and entitled 'No Outsiders Reclaiming Radical Ideas in Schools'.

0:12:44.740,0:12:48.770 Andrew is an assistant head teacher who encountered fierce opposition when he

0:12:48.770,0:12:52.250 tried to teach about equality and diversity in his primary school in

0:12:52.250,0:12:56.580 Birmingham. Here's Andrew. (Andrew Moffat) So, I'd like to show you some

0:12:56.580,0:13:01.060 the books that we use. This is one of them. You'll be forgiven for thinking by looking

0:13:01.060,0:13:06.640 at the various MPs and protesters, that all our books are all about gay people.

0:13:06.640,0:13:10.560 I'm going to show you the books that I use, not all of them - there's 35 books that I use. -

0:13:10.560,0:13:14.260 I've based the whole scheme on this book. Actually I think this book

0:13:14.260,0:13:17.800 is absolutely brilliant. It starts the whole scheme off: Red Rockets and

0:13:17.800,0:13:21.490 Rainbow Jelly. I use this book with four-year-olds. It's about Nick and

0:13:21.490,0:13:27.860 Sue. There's Nick and there's Sue. Nick likes red apples and Sue likes green pears.

0:13:27.860,0:13:31.330

He likes yellow socks and she likes yellow ducks.

He likes orange hair

0:13:31.330,0:13:35.260

and she likes purple hair. On every page Nick and Sue like different things.

0:13:35.260,0:13:40.940

Cats and hats and cars and dinosaurs and jelly. But last page says

0:13:40.940,0:13:45.500

that Nick likes Sue and Sue likes Nick. And that's the end of the story.

0:13:45.500,0:13:49.160

So what's the message in that story? The message is that you can like different things

0:13:49.160,0:13:52.660 and you can still be friends. It's as simple as that. And as

0:13:52.660,0:13:57.180

we grow through our school, we talk about how we're different - different skin,

0:13:57.180,0:14:01.060

different abilities, different faiths, but it all starts with apples and pears

0:14:01.060.0:14:05.020

with four-year-olds. There's a bit of work there from a four-year-old:

0:14:05.020.0:14:09.360

"We like different things. Naya likes dolls and Samaya likes cars. We're all friends."

0:14:09.360,0:14:13.390 Those are all the books that I'm using with four-year-olds.

0:14:13.390,0:14:17.580 Bless him, Roger Godsiff MP talked about this book called

0:14:17.580,0:14:22.000

"Why is gotcha gay?" I've never heard of that

Apparently it's in my scheme.

0:14:22.000,0:14:26.520

No, it's not. These are all the books in my scheme.

You can buy them all in Waterstones.

0:14:26.520,0:14:30.660

You'll notice that Elmer is there.

Elmer has been around schools for 30 years.

0:14:30.740,0:14:34.500

These are the books that I am using. Now there is one book there

0:14:34.510,0:14:40.090

which is, apparently, controversial, which is a Mommy, Mama and Me. I use this

0:14:40.090,0:14:43.300

one for four-year-olds because I want children to understand that

0:14:43.300,0:14:48.730

some families have different makeups. Some families have a mum and a dad,

0:14:48.730,0:14:54.430

some have just a mum, some have just a dad, some live with their grandma or grandpa,

0:14:54.430.0:14:58.000

some have two mums, some have two dads, some live in a foster family,

0:14:58.000,0:15:01.900 All families are different.

0:15:05.260,0:15:10.680

We've been doing this for four years and it has worked fantastically ,so what went

wrong?

0:15:10.680,0:15:16.160 In October last year the government put out for consultation for new

0:15:16.160,0:15:19.550

RSE guidance, relationship and sex

education, and it's right they did that

0:15:19.550,0:15:25.610 because it's been 18 years since the last one. Lots of rumors started

0:15:25.610,0:15:29.960 spreading around about what this would mean for sex education in schools.

0:15:29.960,0:15:34.020 There's a really interesting video on YouTube You can look it up: Dr Kate Godfrey-Faussett.

0:15:34.020,0:15:37.640 I'm sure she wont mind me plugging her. A parent came to me in

0:15:37.640,0:15:40.760

December and said

"Mr Moffat, you've got to watch this video.

0:15:40.760,0:15:44.720 Everyone's talking about it. It's going around the community like wildfire."

0:15:44.720,0:15:48.650 I watched it on Christmas Eve. It ruined my Christmas, because

0:15:48.650,0:15:54.300 on the left-hand side is what this video is saying. It's saying that the new RSE guidelines

0:15:54.300,0:15:59.340 are going to be like this kind of stuff: teaching four-year-olds pornography,

0:15:59.340,0:16:03.380 sexualizing young children, their innocence is going to be destroyed,

0:16:03.380,0:16:06.920 it's a war on spirituality, it's a war on morality. If we do nothing our

0:16:06.920,0:16:12.410 children will be lost and it's brainwashing children. Now, suddenly, in 0:16:12.410,0:16:17.330 January, the first week back, we started having petitions for the first time ever

0:16:17.330,0:16:22.490 about No Outsiders, about sexualizing children "you're secualising children", and

0:16:22.490,0:16:26.720 photocopies of some of the books that I use. And very, very

0:16:26.720,0:16:32.150 quickly people are linking No Outsiders to sex education. Now there's no sex

0:16:32.150,0:16:35.690 in No Outsiders, there's no books about how babies are made, no naked

0:16:35.690,0:16:40.250 bodies, nothing at all. But, because I talk about LGBT people in four of the

0:16:40.250,0:16:45.440 books, four out of 35, it's a very easy thing to pick on: "Look! Here's an example

0:16:45.440,0:16:53.620 of what's going to be happening in all schools." (EP) A full video of all of the Bradlaugh Lectures

0:16:53.620,0:16:58.160 given so far is available now and will be in the program notes. I'm now

0:16:58.170,0:17:01.680 going to be talking to Alastair about the latest data about faith schools

0:17:01.680,0:17:05.340 which the National Secular Society has obtained from the Department for

0:17:05.340,0:17:09.600 Education, through a Freedom of Information request. Alastair, could you

0:17:09.600,0:17:14.740 explain what questions you asked in your

FOI request and what information you obtained?

0:17:14.740,0:17:20.520 (AL) Thanks, Emma. So the first thing to note is these figures are for England only.

0:17:20.520,0:17:24.080 We think there are similar issues elsewhere in the UK, but just the way the data

0:17:24.090,0:17:28.530 works meant there had to be an English-only focus.

0:17:28.530,0:17:34.820 These are updated figures, so we did similar FOI requests in 2017 and 2018.

0:17:34.820,0:17:39.320 They formed a significant part of our major report on this which was

0:17:39.330,0:17:43.590 published in December, called The Choice Delusion, which really looked at how

0:17:43.590,0:17:49.020 faith schools undermine choice for many parents in England.

0:17:49.020,0:17:53.550 The basic question, which we've now asked for

0:17:53.550,0:17:56.780 the third year in a row, is how many children were assigned a faith school

0:17:56.780,0:18:02.640 after their parents requested a non-faith school. The figures show, for the

0:18:02.640,0:18:07.580 second year in a row, a rise. It's just over 20,600.

0:18:07.580,0:18:13.640 That includes over 12,000 children sent to secondary faith schools despite 0:18:13.640,0:18:22.560 parental preference for a non-faith school, and just over 8000 sent to primary faith schools,

0:18:22.560,0:18:27.360 against their parents preferences. Now, I think it's important to note right at the

0:18:27.360,0:18:31.620 beginning that these figures aren't definitive. But they add to the evidence

0:18:31.620,0:18:37.490 showing the many problems with the faith school choice narrative.

0:18:37.490,0:18:43.900
(EP) What is that faith school choice narrative?
(AL) Well it's the number one justification

0:18:43.900,0:18:48.480 given by many people for why we have faith-based schools. It is that

0:18:48.480,0:18:52.440 they promote choice. This is one of the things we encountered

0:18:52.440,0:18:57.060 when creating the No More Faith Schools campaign, is to say faith schools

0:18:57.060,0:19:01.460 support choice does kind of make a bit of an intrinsic sense.

0:19:01.460,0:19:06.320 Actually unpacking that and showing why that's kind of a flawed way of

0:19:06.320,0:19:10.820 looking at it. You can't say that in five seconds. You've got to bring in data.

0:19:10.820,0:19:15.580 You've got to unpack the various hidden assumptions in that.

0:19:15.580,0:19:20.450

(EP) How many of the parents in this report that you're talking about put a faith

0:19:20.450,0:19:24.920 school as their second choice? (AL) We don't actually know the exact data on how

0:19:24.920,0:19:29.510 many put a faith school as their second choice. Parents, depending on which area they

0:19:29.510,0:19:34.760 live in, can make three to six choices. I think five is a quite typical number.

0:19:34.760,0:19:41.520 We know that over 4300 people in September 2019, that's where these figures are from,

0:19:41.520,0:19:46.520 were assigned faith schools, despite no faith schools being anywhere in

0:19:46.520,0:19:53.030 their preferences. Again, it's important to unpack the

0:19:53.030,0:19:58.370 data behind these figures, and to consider why some people might make the

0:19:58.370,0:20:03.710 choice of a faith school within their six choices, despite not actually

0:20:03.710,0:20:09.200 wanting a faith school. I've certainly dealt with casework with parents who say

0:20:09.200,0:20:13.280 well we really didn't want a faith school, we didn't get into any of

0:20:13.280,0:20:17.360 our non faith schools, we were assigned this C of E school that was our third choice.

0:20:17.360,0:20:21.260 Well, why did you put it as a third choice? Many parents think if you have the

0:20:21.260,0:20:25.340 option for six choices that you need to put them all in. Parents might say

0:20:25.360,0:20:29.300
"Oh, I really don't want this faith school but I definitely don't want a school

0:20:29.300,0:20:35.720 that's five or six miles away." Equally, parents may put a faith school as

0:20:35.720,0:20:38.900 one of their choices because they just don't have any other options.

0:20:38.900,0:20:43.880
If you have one school in the village your choices are pretty limited, and that's

0:20:43.880,0:20:49.520 the other side of the story that we we went

0:20:49.520,0:20:55.310 through in The Choice Delusion report. (EP) Is there any possibility that, say, parents

0:20:55.310,0:20:59.300 might want to send their children to a faith school but there there weren't any

0:20:59.300,0:21:03.530 faith schools in the area? (AL) Yeah. Equally, we can we can look at that

0:21:03.530,0:21:09.200 data, so there will be, within within that 20,600,

0:21:09.200,0:21:12.680 there's going to be obviously some anomalies either way. There will be

0:21:12.680,0:21:15.759 many people whoput a faith school despite not wanting

0:21:15.759,0:21:21.100 one, and there will be some parents who

want a faith school but I haven't put

0:21:21.100,0:21:25.990 one as options. The difference in funding for transport to faith schools means

0:21:25.990,0:21:31.269 that if a parent absolutely, positively wants a faith school, even if it's

0:21:31.269,0:21:35.769 nowhere near their nearest school, it's quite a long way away, they can, generally

0:21:35.769,0:21:38.799 speaking, put that as a preference and are likely to get it if they meet the

0:21:38.799,0:21:45.399 faith-based criteria. Even it means going past six suitable non-faith schools,

0:21:45.399,0:21:49.210 the council will probably cover the transport for that. (EP) But that doesn't

0:21:49.210,0:21:53.480 apply if a parent wants a non-faith school? (AL) In practice, no.

(EP) What are the National Secular Society's main objections to the fact that parents are

0:21:57.780,0:22:01.800 often effectively forced to send their children to faith schools?

(AL) Well I think our main objection is this sort of this perverse thing, that you hear all

0:22:08.139,0:22:11.529 the time, about "faith schools promote choice", and that

0:22:11.529,0:22:16.720 ignores all people who have no choice but a faith school, or are not able to

0:22:16.720,0:22:21.779 choose their local school because of religious discrimination in admissions.

0:22:21.779,0:22:26.049 You have the right to raise your children in accordance with your beliefs.

0:22:26.049,0:22:31.929

Now that doesn't entitle you to a faith school but it certainly should entitle

0:22:31.929,0:22:35.549 you to a school that doesn't go against your religious beliefs.

0:22:35.549,0:22:40.480 In The Choice Delusion report we had around, I think, thirty short stories.

0:22:40.480,0:22:46.140 Case studies and parents are saying things like "We're not a religious family.

0:22:46.140,0:22:50.019
So if you are a religious family and you send your child to a

0:22:50.020,0:22:53.800 faith school and they're reinforcing that belief, that's fine.

0:22:53.800,0:22:58.800
If you don't share those beliefs then, as a parent, how do

0:22:58.809,0:23:03.580 you actively counter, how do you deal with your child being taken to

0:23:03.580,0:23:07.960 school and taught something which goes against your very fundamental values?"

0:23:07.960,0:23:10.179 That's an experience that just doesn't happen

0:23:10.179,0:23:15.759 if your child is sent to a non-faith school, a community ethos school, a religiously

0:23:15.759,0:23:23.649 non-directive school. No child is sent to a community school, or shouldn't be, and

0:23:23.649,0:23:28.360 taught that their beliefs, that they're raising their family wrong.

0:23:28.360,0:23:33.250 Striving for a neutral, inclusive atmosphere doesn't

0:23:33.250,0:23:37.990 disadvantage anyone in that same way. (EP) So the point you're making is

0:23:37.990,0:23:45.070 that non-faith schools do not impose a particular direction on children, whereas

0:23:45.070,0:23:49.659
faith schools do?
(AL) Yes and obviously they vary to the degree

0:23:49.659,0:23:54.730 which they impose that faith direction. Non faith schools aren't imposing

0:23:54.730,0:23:59.799 non faith. It's the idea of

0:23:59.799,0:24:03.820 faith and non faith are opposites. I'ts a bit weird, where actually

0:24:03.820,0:24:07.120 faith is one end of the scale and there's no other end of the scale, and

0:24:07.120,0:24:10.980 you've got community ethos schools in the middle.
(EP) Because, with no faith

0:24:10.980,0:24:14.860 there's simply nothing to be imposed. How far are parents really

concerned about sending their children to a faith school? Do you have any

0:24:18.220,0:24:25.720 specific data or feedback on this issue? (AL) Well it's an area of growing concern,

0:24:25.720,0:24:30.600 partly as the country becomes much more religiously diverse and

0:24:30.610,0:24:35.230 increasingly non-religious. Obviously parents will tend to be towards the

0:24:35.230,0:24:39.789 younger end of the population, their children obviously even younger, so this

0:24:39.789,0:24:45.490 is an age group that are overwhelmingly increasingly likely to be non-religious,

0:24:45.490,0:24:50.710 to not have religion as part of their life, and don't expect religion to be a

0:24:50.710,0:24:56.320 central part of any other public service which they wish they wish to access.

0:24:56.320,0:25:02.220 We featured dozens, around 30 case studies and short stories in

0:25:02.230,0:25:06.580 the report, of people in this position. It's something that regularly comes up in

0:25:06.580,0:25:12.010 comments in response to our faith schools petition. So, yes, it's

0:25:12.010,0:25:15.639 clearly an issue that affects many people. Even taking the very

0:25:15.640,0:25:22.060 smallest end of the scale of these figures, this is around 4,300 pupils,

0:25:26.080,0:25:30.440 would seem to indicate that the parents want a non faith school,

0:25:40.450,0:25:45.360 choice, this is serious issue that is just not being grappled with.

0:25:45.360,0:25:50.600 (EP) Could you just say very quickly a bit about the Choice Delusion Report?

0:25:50.600,0:25:55.400 (AL) These figures should be seen, I think, as an update.

0:25:55.400,0:25:59.210 These are the 2019 figures, and the Choice Delusion Report looked at the

0:25:59.210,0:26:05.610 2017 and 2018 figures. The Choice Delusion Report I think was pretty groundbreaking,

0:26:05.610,0:26:11.519 because the government have been asked over the years various times by

0:26:11.519,0:26:16.200 different MPs "Do you have an estimate of how many people don't have a

0:26:16.200,0:26:20.220 choice about a faith school? Do you have an estimate of how many are sent to faith

0:26:20.220,0:26:23.879 schools against their parents wishes?"

The government just haven't made any

0:26:23.879,0:26:28.619 estimate, so the NSS analyzing this data, the research that went

0:26:28.619,0:26:33.809 into The Choice Delusion Report, this was the first of its type of any scale to estimate,

0:26:33.809,0:26:38.180 a pretty good estimate, of what the figures are.

The analysis we've done now for the third year running on this, showing it's a

0:26:42.059,0:26:45.659 problem affecting tens of thousands of families, not being done by other organizations,

0:26:45.660,0:26:50.780 certainly not being doneby the government. (EP) So, moving from the statistics

0:26:50.780,0:26:54.779 to the practice, how far in practice do faith schools really impose

0:26:54.780,0:26:59.560 a particular religion on students from a non-religious background?

(AL) This is something that varies quite widely. I never, as an anti faith school campaigner, sit

0:27:06.240,0:27:13.380 and pretend that all faith schools are 9 to 5 indoctrination.

0:27:13.380,0:27:17.680 No-one pretends it's all schools at that that sort of level. Everyone acknowledges

0:27:17.690,0:27:23.999 there is a wide range of practice, in terms of how aggressively this religious 0:27:23.999,0:27:30.029 ethos is promoted in schools. But faith schools all exist to promote a religious

0:27:30.029,0:27:35.279 ethos, and they all do it to some extent. There's a term 'indoctrination' which

0:27:35.279,0:27:41.369
I think can put some people off - scary word. But I think of

0:27:41.369,0:27:47.549 it as a scale. You've got inculcation, immersion and indoctrination.

0:27:47.549,0:27:53.549 Inculcation is that softer pushing, guiding people towards a religious

0:27:53.549,0:27:57.930 ethos, or at least a positive view of religion. This idea

0:27:57.930,0:28:03.510 that faith schools have of immersion: so faith schools may not be trying to turn

0:28:03.510,0:28:08.820 children into members of that faith, but they're trying to create this idea that

0:28:08.820,0:28:13.980 the world is a very religious world and surround them, immerse them, in these

0:28:13.980,0:28:19.080 religious ideas, to make what is just not normal for most families. It's not

0:28:19.080,0:28:23.730 saying there's anything wrong with it, but just isn't the normal experience of the

0:28:23.730,0:28:27.690 vast majority of people in the country, this very religious community,

0:28:27.690,0:28:32.750 and trying to make that seem as if that's normal.

0:28:32.750,0:28:41.040
Often C of E schools in the past were not seen as particularly faith

0:28:41.040,0:28:47.640 promotional. Often you saw C of E faith schools were kind of faith

0:28:47.640,0:28:51.180 schools by a sort of a historical accident. But there's definitely been, in recent

0:28:51.180,0:28:55.660 years, an increased focus on promoting their faith within those schools.

0:28:55.660,0:29:00.840 (EP) Do you have any particular examples? (AL) Yes. We've got case studies and some of the

0:29:00.840,0:29:07.200 testimonials on the No More Faith Schools site from teachers and governor's at C of E faith

0:29:07.200,0:29:12.900 schools about how there's the pressure to promote a religious ethos. I see

0:29:12.900,0:29:18.300 it a lot in the case work, particularly examples from

0:29:18.300,0:29:24.280 collective worship etc, that parents might say "This was the only school in the village.

0:29:24.380,0:29:28.760 It was a C of E faith school. I went to

0:29:28.760,0:29:31.410 a C of E faith school when I was young that didn't seem very religious. I was

0:29:31.410,0:29:36.810 actually surprised by just how religious it is." I've chatted

0:29:36.810,0:29:40.020 about the subject with my wife. She attended a C of E faith school that was

0:29:40.020,0:29:46.500 in some ways less religious than my community school. The harm of

0:29:46.500,0:29:51.390 this ethos being promoted - often I think, the C of E in particular, they

0:29:51.390,0:29:54.660 don't really believe that people are non-religious. There's this sort of

0:29:54.660,0:29:59.760 refusal to believe the majority who say they're not religious, and so

0:29:59.760,0:30:05.160 people are sort of seen as Christian by default. So promoting and imposing a

0:30:05.160,0:30:10.000 Christian ethos on people is seen as kind of more neutral and fair.

0:30:10.060,0:30:12.900

(EP) Do you have a particular example of that?

0:30:12.900,0:30:17.730 (AL) Well, we recently wrote up some figures from a survey of teachers which

0:30:17.730,0:30:21.000 very interesting. It incidentally showed a clear majority of

0:30:21.000,0:30:24.940 teachers supporting an end to new faith schools.

(EP) Is this secondary or primary?

0:30:24.940,0:30:28.820 (AL) This is across secondary and primary. We'll link it in the show notes.

0:30:28.820,0:30:33.440 One of the less headliney figures in that actually I found really

0:30:33.450,0:30:37.470

interesting. This was, again, a survey of school teachers in

0:30:37.470,0:30:43.140 England, and it showed that 23% would find it acceptable for a

0:30:43.140,0:30:47.400 child from a non-religious family to be allocated a place against their will at a

0:30:47.400,0:30:53.460 Catholic school, but only 17% would find acceptable for a

0:30:53.460,0:30:58.050 Christian family to be allocated a place against their will at Sikh school. So

0:30:58.050,0:31:00.810 there's clearly a sort of religious hierarchy if you're a

0:31:00.810,0:31:05.060 different religion, obviously having certain religious imposed on you.

0:31:05.060,0:31:10.200 We helped a case where there were twenty families assigned a

0:31:10.200,0:31:13.440 place at a Sikh School against their wishes. People sort of see that

0:31:13.440,0:31:18.120 clearly that's wrong. We've examples with an Islamic

0:31:18.120,0:31:21.630 family assigned placed at Jewish orthodox school, and people see clearly that's

0:31:21.630,0:31:26.820 wrong. But then we had an example a few years ago with, I think, it was six families.

0:31:26.820,0:31:31.560 They were assigned a C of E faith school against their wishes, and the attitude we 0:31:31.560,0:31:35.940

saw there was that "It's a Christian country. You should have to just put up with that."

0:31:35.940,0:31:38.610

(EP) In fact this leads on to my next question which was going

0:31:38.610,0:31:42.630

to be what about parents of one religion being forced to send their children to a

0:31:42.630,0:31:47.360

faith school of another religion. Is this an issue? But it seems that

0:31:47.360,0:31:52.440

there is a difference between the move from one religion to another, as

0:31:52.440.0:31:57.840

opposed to from non religion to a religion. (AP) Yeah. It should be said that

0:31:57.840,0:32:03.720

because there are many families, if they're not religious, perceive, and in

some cases accurately, that Christian faith schools, while less aggressive at

0:32:08.610,0:32:12.540

promoting the ethos, some think
"Oh. I'll be willing to put up with that.

That doesn't seem as bad."

But it's certainly a growing issue, and that's

because minority faith schools, by which I mean Sikh, Hindu,

Islamic, Jewish and smaller Christian sects, they're even less popular among people

who don't share the faith than other larger faith schools,

which means they're very often likely to

be undersubscribed.

So if you've got an area where lots of schools

are

stretched for places and you've got one

minority faith school that's

0:32:47.830,0:32:50.980

undersubscribed, it's much more

likely that you might

0:32:50.980,0:32:55.810

end up being assigned there.

(EP) So, for example, if you're a non religious

person

in an area where the other schools are oversubscribed you might end up being

0:32:59.860,0:33:05.110

assigned to a Sikh school?

(AL) Yeah. I think that's in terms of

0:33:05.110,0:33:09.270

single cases, Sikh schools are one of the one of the biggest examples.

You have these schools that just

really are not attractive to people who

0:33:12.970,0:33:16.360

don't in any way share their

faith. So you have either people

traveling from a long way away which

disrupts the balance in other

schools around the area, so people in

other schools don't get to have Sikh

0:33:26.320,0:33:30.130

friends in the playground, because there's a pressure for Sikh kids to go

0:33:30.130,0:33:34.840 to this one faith school. (EP) What is the National Secular Society doing to

0:33:34.840,0:33:38.740 campaign against the insufficient provision of non faith schools I think?

0:33:38.740,0:33:43.620 (AL) I think research like this is really important, continuing to publish

0:33:43.620,0:33:48.440 this quite groundbreaking report, and then working every year to keep it up to date.

I think we're the only organization that's actually publishing such

0:33:51.580,0:33:56.180 estimates. We're the only ones doing this particular research.

0:33:56.180,0:34:01.060 Our No More Faith Schools campaign and the idea that we were to challenge any new faith

0:34:01.060,0:34:06.850 school proposal is important there. The report contained a series of

0:34:06.850,0:34:12.100 recommendations for the DfE and for local authorities and we've continued to

0:34:12.100,0:34:16.260 raise these issues with local authorities and Department for Education.

0:34:16.260,0:34:22.810 We encourage them to monitor these issues and to plan new schools to

0:34:22.810,0:34:26.890 address them, to set up a

methodology, through this report

0:34:26.890,0:34:30.610 it's a methodology, which allows us to provide some data when responding to

0:34:30.610,0:34:35.120 consultations saying that this proposed new faith school is not

0:34:35.120,0:34:42.260 necessary. We've made recommendations which require a bit of policy change,

0:34:42.260,0:34:45.860 a bit of change in thinking. We've made other recommendations which do require

0:34:45.860,0:34:51.830 legal changes, which we need to campaign for, and work for over time, to make it easier

0:34:51.830,0:34:56.510 for a school community to downgrade or to remove religious ethos, to make the

0:34:56.510,0:35:01.160 school more inclusive. We'd like there to be a secular entitlement of some sort,

0:35:01.160,0:35:06.380 at the minimum to have every child have the the option of a community ethos school.
