This episode is about secularism in

Poland. Historically

Poland has long been a Catholic country.

Catholicism was suppressed under the Soviet occupation

from the end of World War II until the fall of the Berlin Wall.

Since then, however, a new agreement with the Vatican has resulted in a greater

promotion of Catholic interests.

At the same time, Poland has a basically

secular constitution

and public support for the Catholic

0:00:40.559,0:00:45.120

church itself has waned considerably in the wake of the child abuse scandal.

Nonetheless Poland continues to have restrictive laws about women's

reproductive rights.

LGBT rights are also under threat but how

much public support is there for free access to abortion?

What about the teaching of LGBT identities in schools?

Is the trend in Poland towards greater conservatism or greater liberalism?

To answer these questions and more I will be speaking to Kaja Bryx, President

I'm joined now by Kaya Bryx, who is President of the Polish Rationalist

Kaya, thank you so much for joining us

today. (KB): Thank you for the invitation. (EP): How secular would you say Poland's

0:01:50.640,0:01:55.200

constitution is as a matter of law and what is the the relationship between

0:01:55.200,0:02:00.159

the Church and the State in Poland? (KB): Well we do have definitely a

0:02:00.159,0:02:03.680

separation of the State and the churches but we

0:02:03.680,0:02:07.680

definitely don't have the secularism model like the

0:02:07.680,0:02:11.760

French Laissez Faire because according to our

0:02:11.760,0:02:15.440

constitution the public authorities remain

0:02:15.440,0:02:18.319

impartial in the matters related to religious

or philosophical beliefs but at the same time

0:02:22.319,0:02:26.319

they ensure everyone's freedom to express their beliefs

in public. So well we definitely have secularism here.

The problem is that at the same time the constitution mentions that the

agreements that the Polish State will have with different religious

associations will determine the rules of these

associations. The constitution mentions that rules

will be as per the agreements between the state and each religious association

and it mentions that the Catholic church has a special agreement with the Polish

State which is the Concorde which was signed in 1993 and ratified in 1998

and this international agreement which we have with the Holy See

well give lots of privileges to the Catholic church.

And today actually for many years now we've been discussing in Poland that it

would be great to change these rules because

they are
not in line with secularism

as we would like to see it. But in order
to

change the agreements with the
Catholic church we would have to first

change the constitution. (EP):
What are these special privileges? Can

0:03:41.599,0:03:45.280
you give an example of some of the
privileges which the Catholic church has

0:03:45.280,0:03:49.280
in Poland at the moment. (KB): Well they
have lots of economical

0:03:49.280,0:03:53.519
privileges.
They don't pay taxes,

0:03:53.519,0:04:00.080
they have received
lands that have been taken from them

0:04:00.080,0:04:05.200
in 1950 when basically all properties
were nationalised

0:04:05.200,0:04:09.200
and at the same time a special Church
Fund was created

0:04:09.200,0:04:12.840
as a compensation for the church. So
after

0:04:12.840,0:04:18.720
1989 there was this special
commission, property commission, that was

0:04:18.720,0:04:21.600
giving back
the properties of different religious

0:04:21.600,0:04:26.880
associations which in principle
was a very good thing. But the problem

0:04:26.880,0:04:30.880
was that it was
very corrupted and that the Catholic

0:04:30.880,0:04:35.520
church
received lots of properties

0:04:35.520,0:04:38.960
with fake values which later they were
reselling

0:04:38.960,0:04:44.320
at a triple price and they
made a lot of money out of it. This

0:04:44.320,0:04:48.880
commission was
circa 2011 and members of this

0:04:48.880,0:04:53.840
commission are now being prosecuted
for corruption. But the Catholic church

0:04:53.840,0:04:57.280
is not prosecuted in any way so they
have lots of properties,

they have lots of rights when it comes
to

0:05:00.960,0:05:04.639
charity organisations that they don't
need to fulfill the

0:05:04.639,0:05:10.000
the usual criteria, and at the same time
the Church Fund which was created

0:05:10.000,0:05:15.120
as a compensation for the lost
properties in 1950 is still in place.

So the State is still paying for this
fund

0:05:18.479,0:05:23.120
which covers social insurance and health
insurance of the priests.

The problem with this commission, the
biggest problem was, that there was no

0:05:26.800,0:05:31.120
appeal.
So a small group of people just decided

0:05:31.120,0:05:34.400
that
this hospital or this school or this

0:05:34.400,0:05:38.000
cinema
once belonged to the Catholic church and

0:05:38.000,0:05:43.199
sometimes they actually went
back to some documents from 14th century

0:05:43.199,0:05:46.960
and they decided that okay in the 14th
century this belongs to the Catholic

church so now it should be
given back to them and there was no way

0:05:51.120,0:05:54.800
to stop it,
and no way to appeal. (EP): So it's a large

0:05:54.800,0:05:59.280
potential
for corruption then but you say that

0:05:59.280,0:06:03.360
there's been a movement to discuss

0:06:03.360,0:06:08.160
abolishing these special privileges.
What's the current situation? Because

0:06:08.160,0:06:11.520
recently of course the Law and
Justice Party

0:06:11.520,0:06:15.440
last autumn was elected for its second
term, the very conservative

0:06:15.440,0:06:20.560
Catholic party and is now the
governing party in a coalition

0:06:20.560,0:06:25.759
in Poland and President Andrei Duda
has just been elected for a

0:06:25.759,0:06:28.560
second term and he's
former member of the Law and Justice

0:06:28.560,0:06:33.440
Party. How is
their power affecting the

0:06:33.440,0:06:35.759
situation
of the Catholic church in Poland? Does

0:06:35.759,0:06:40.720
that mean that these reforms
are going to be on the back burner? Well

0:06:40.720,0:06:44.400
luckily
for us this government and this

0:06:44.400,0:06:48.240
President
they say lots of things which

0:06:48.240,0:06:51.520
usually are something you wouldn't like to hear.

0:06:51.520,0:06:54.720
But legally they haven't done many changes.

0:06:54.720,0:07:01.919
So either they are not capable of doing them or maybe they don't really

0:07:01.919,0:07:06.319
want to make them real as much as they like to

speak about these things. Definitely the climate has changed a lot

in Poland, in the sense that the church

0:07:14.000,0:07:18.160
is heard more. One of the first things that this

0:07:18.160,0:07:22.960
Government did was changing the role of the public

0:07:22.960,0:07:26.960
media which basically turned into a propaganda

0:07:26.960,0:07:30.720
tube of the Government. We actually used to have a problem with

0:07:30.720,0:07:35.759
that even before that it was always too much connected to the ruling party,

0:07:35.759,0:07:39.280
the public TV especially, but

0:07:39.280,0:07:43.759
since Law and Justice is in power they

have openly made it their propaganda

0:07:43.759,0:07:47.680
tube and they have given more time for the Catholic church

0:07:47.680,0:07:51.599
representatives. They have a lot of films, documents that

0:07:51.599,0:07:56.400
are supposed to teach Catholic values but actually

0:07:56.400,0:08:00.479
they do it, I mean having it as a propaganda tube this is

0:08:00.479,0:08:04.479
definitely not right, but the Christian values -

0:08:04.479,0:08:09.039
they are there in the rules for the public TV,

0:08:09.039,0:08:14.800
as decided in 2009: that the public TV should actually

0:08:14.800,0:08:17.599
support Christian values. It was decided by the

0:08:17.599,0:08:21.759
Parliament in 2009 when Civic Platform was

0:08:21.759,0:08:27.520
in power. (EP): Okay so it's been around for quite a long time but I mean

0:08:27.520,0:08:31.840
you say that this Government is is currently talking more than

0:08:31.840,0:08:35.360
it's acting. What is that in relation to

because

I mean it's certainly the case isn't it that they're very much opposed to

0:08:40.080,0:08:44.320

things like certain liberties like women's reproductive rights,

LGBT rights and they've sought to sort of

0:08:47.839,0:08:50.880

undermine the independence of the judiciary.

I mean how far has this had practical effects?

0:08:54.880,0:08:59.040

(KB): Will definitely the independence of the judiciary - this the most serious

0:08:59.040,0:09:02.880

issue.

They have changed the way the National

0:09:02.880,0:09:06.959

Council of the Judiciary works, so the council which nominates

0:09:06.959,0:09:11.519

judges.

And they have just terminated the

0:09:11.519,0:09:15.360

the term of the current members of this council

0:09:15.360,0:09:19.040

and they appointed new ones. And ever since

0:09:19.040,0:09:22.399

this new Council, appointed by the

current parliament,

0:09:22.399,0:09:28.000

has been appointing new judges. At the same time they have introduced a Bill

0:09:28.000,0:09:34.800

which says that you cannot be a judge anymore once

0:09:34.800,0:09:39.920

you're 65 years old

which is quite absurd in this profession.

There are many many judges who actually

0:09:43.519,0:09:46.720

work

all around the world at their 70s and

0:09:46.720,0:09:51.120

80s and even

older because what matters is their

0:09:51.120,0:09:54.720

expertise.

So they are actually considered very

0:09:54.720,0:09:58.240

valuable. (EP):

Is the idea with reducing the age

0:09:58.240,0:10:02.079

limit to 65 that they will then be able

to replace judges more quickly with

0:10:02.079,0:10:06.640

their own

preferred candidates? (KB): Yes although as an

0:10:06.640,0:10:09.680

explanation from their side well they used

0:10:09.680,0:10:14.240

the argument that many of these elderly

judges

0:10:14.240,0:10:17.360
were actually related to the Communist regime

0:10:17.360,0:10:24.320
which we had pre-1989 in Poland and some of them actually, well were

0:10:24.320,0:10:28.760
responsible for
for what happened to the opposition for

0:10:28.760,0:10:33.680
incarcerations, even
for deaths of people. The problem

0:10:33.680,0:10:39.200
is that we don't know exactly
which of these judges were responsible.

0:10:39.200,0:10:42.399
But that was the argument
which

0:10:42.399,0:10:46.000
many Polish people accepted that yes,
these

0:10:46.000,0:10:50.240
people were related to that regime and
now they are still

0:10:50.240,0:10:55.680
judges and some of them actually
are criminals themselves. (EP):

0:10:55.680,0:10:59.360
It's a good sort of pretext
potentially.

0:10:59.360,0:11:02.720
(KB): Yes but but of course it meant that a
lot of judges

0:11:02.720,0:11:06.480
were now replaced with younger people

0:11:06.480,0:11:11.040
by the new Council. (EP): How far have these
reforms

0:11:11.040,0:11:14.320
in practice, how far have they meant that
it is

0:11:14.320,0:11:19.600
say more difficult for women to get
an abortion in Poland?

0:11:19.600,0:11:23.040
Have people who are LGBT found
themselves

0:11:23.040,0:11:27.279
more under pressure as a result of these
changes and as a result of the

0:11:27.279,0:11:31.200
current atmosphere in Poland? (KB): Let's talk
maybe about the

0:11:31.200,0:11:34.800
the abortion, the health and reproductive
rights first.

0:11:34.800,0:11:38.640
Because actually I think there is a
quite a big misconception

0:11:38.640,0:11:42.560
regarding this topic abroad. Because
this Government

0:11:42.560,0:11:49.360
has actually not done anything to
make the situation of women worse. We had

0:11:49.360,0:11:56.240
civic bills. This is very interesting. So
the project of these bills to

0:11:56.240,0:11:59.279
abolish abortion completely, they came
from

0:11:59.279,0:12:03.279

civil society. So Catholic organisations basically

0:12:03.279,0:12:07.279

who got enough signatories to submit these projects

0:12:07.279,0:12:11.200

to the Parliament. And there was this very very horrific

0:12:11.200,0:12:18.240

project which was submitted in 2017 that was to ban abortion completely.

0:12:18.240,0:12:24.560

And also there was this point about in case of miscarriage there should be

0:12:24.560,0:12:29.680

a prosecutor involved to investigate whether it was done on purpose or not

0:12:29.680,0:12:35.279

and there was a penalty of jail meant for women who would have done an

0:12:35.279,0:12:39.920

abortion.
So this was a really horrible Bill and

0:12:39.920,0:12:44.000

this is why we had these huge protests - Black Protests. I'm sure you've heard

0:12:44.000,0:12:47.120

about them?
(EP): Yes, and it was successful in

0:12:47.120,0:12:50.079

overturning,
preventing that Bill from coming into

0:12:50.079,0:12:54.800

law. (KB): Yes and luckily this Bill was rejected by the Parliament.

0:12:54.800,0:12:56.959

(EP): Do you think there's a possibility that such a Bill might

0:12:56.959,0:13:00.399

be raised again and be passed successfully and then ...

0:13:00.399,0:13:04.480

(KB): There is another project done by the same organisation

0:13:04.480,0:13:07.680

which has been submitted to the Parliament recently

0:13:07.680,0:13:10.880

but this project is very different, luckily.

0:13:10.880,0:13:14.320

I mean it's still not good and I hope they will reject it again.

0:13:14.320,0:13:17.600

For now it's been moved to the Commissions

0:13:17.600,0:13:21.120

where it may remain for a few years in fact

0:13:21.120,0:13:27.600

before the parliament decides on it. So at the moment we still have the same

0:13:27.600,0:13:31.160

law about the reproductive rights which we have since

0:13:31.160,0:13:37.440

1993 which says that in general abortion is illegal but there are three

0:13:37.440,0:13:40.800

exceptions
which are accepted and that's in case a

0:13:40.800,0:13:45.760

woman's life is
endangered or there is severe fetus

0:13:45.760,0:13:52.480

disease, genetic disorder or in case of
rape. (EP): So it's still pretty restrictive

0:13:52.480,0:13:56.399

but I mean what what is the organisation
which is trying to

0:13:56.399,0:14:00.720

put forward an even more restrictive
Bill? (EP): The organisation's name is Ordo

0:14:00.720,0:14:04.399

luris.
(EP): Oh it's Ordo luris, okay right so the

0:14:04.399,0:14:08.000

very
traditional Catholic, conservative

0:14:08.000,0:14:11.360

organisation. (KB): Yes but there are a few
more,

0:14:11.360,0:14:16.399

similar organisations in Poland. So they
actually joined forces for these

0:14:16.399,0:14:21.760

projects. (EP): And is the same thing, do they
still now are they still pushing in

0:14:21.760,0:14:24.880

this new Bill would it be for an another
effective completed

0:14:24.880,0:14:28.079

ban on abortion? (KB): They have given up for
now

0:14:28.079,0:14:33.279

on pushing for a total ban on abortion
which clearly shows that actually the

0:14:33.279,0:14:38.320

political climate is not
to ban it completely. I still hope

0:14:38.320,0:14:41.680

that
this project will be rejected as

0:14:41.680,0:14:46.320

well.
But we have managed to defend the

0:14:46.320,0:14:50.480

status quo
for now, which is well not that bad.

0:14:50.480,0:14:54.399

But of course we can expect new projects
as well in the future, I mean

0:14:54.399,0:14:58.000

this is a kind of fight that might
continue

0:14:58.000,0:15:01.279

for decades. (EP): What is the Polish
Rationalist

0:15:01.279,0:15:05.360

Association's stance on abortion, what
would you like to see the law

0:15:05.360,0:15:12.959

becoming? (KB): Well we would like to
see a free access to abortion. That's

0:15:12.959,0:15:17.440

what we believe would be the best -
for a woman to choose freely

0:15:17.440,0:15:21.600

whether she would like to continue
with the pregnancy or not.

0:15:21.600,0:15:25.519

(EP): How much support does that view have
in Poland at the moment?

0:15:25.519,0:15:29.199
(KB): I would say not much. I was there at the Black Protests

0:15:29.199,0:15:33.920
and I interviewed lots of people at the time because I was interested

0:15:33.920,0:15:37.040
in knowing their opinions . So I did a poll

0:15:37.040,0:15:40.160
about whether these people who are protesting

0:15:40.160,0:15:45.279
against the the abortion ban, would they like to have a free access to abortion

0:15:45.279,0:15:48.959
in all cases,
or whether they would prefer to

0:15:48.959,0:15:53.759
remain with
what we have right now. And well 90%

0:15:53.759,0:15:58.160
of these women who were protesting actually preferred the current status

0:15:58.160,0:16:00.560
quo. (EP): How high a proportion of the population

0:16:00.560,0:16:05.680
is Catholic?
(KB): It's hard to say. Well officially

0:16:05.680,0:16:10.639
it's 93% but
here we are talking about people who are

0:16:10.639,0:16:15.759
baptised and
in fact when we look at the statistics

0:16:15.759,0:16:19.279
that
the Catholic church does about 40%

0:16:19.279,0:16:24.959
of these people go to the Sunday Mass. (EP): So there is this big gap there.

0:16:24.959,0:16:28.160
(KB): Yesh so we would say that most people in Poland

0:16:28.160,0:16:31.759
are baptised and they probably celebrate Christmas,

0:16:31.759,0:16:38.399
and they do believe in some sort of god and maybe an afterlife

0:16:38.399,0:16:44.639
but they are not that much connected to to the Catholicism itself and they don't

0:16:44.639,0:16:50.800
feel connected to the church. In fact recently the paedophilia

0:16:50.800,0:16:57.839
topic arose finally after so many years of being covered.

0:16:57.839,0:17:02.399
This huge scandal really changed the way the Polish people perceive the Catholic

0:17:02.399,0:17:06.559
church today.
So yes definitely from the side of the

0:17:06.559,0:17:10.400
Government,
you can feel that, of course they are

0:17:10.400,0:17:15.280
very conservative

and very religious and the way they say

0:17:15.280,0:17:19.360

things . Well I really don't watch the public TV

0:17:19.360,0:17:26.319

anymore because I can't stand it. But luckily the society, it's changing for

0:17:26.319,0:17:30.960

the better.

Let us move on to another problematic

0:17:30.960,0:17:33.840

issue in Poland at the moment which is the position of

0:17:33.840,0:17:39.919

LGBT people and others. What's their situation is it?

0:17:39.919,0:17:44.960

Because recently there have been some cities in Poland isn't there which have

0:17:44.960,0:17:50.320

proclaimed that they're LGBT free. (KB): Yes well precisely they proclaim

0:17:50.320,0:17:55.760

that they are free of LGBT ideology.

0:17:55.760,0:18:02.000

I know it's still so bad but it there is a small difference

0:18:02.000,0:18:05.120

between that because when you hear LGBT free

0:18:05.120,0:18:08.799

you have immediately, or at least I have this association that,

0:18:08.799,0:18:11.919

you have these signs in the restaurant

that

0:18:11.919,0:18:15.120

LGBT people cannot enter and stuff like that.

0:18:15.120,0:18:21.360

Basically the battle here is about sexual education in schools and

0:18:21.360,0:18:28.799

any presence of LGBT associations or NGOs that fight for LGBT rights,

0:18:28.799,0:18:35.200

that any presence of them would be not allowed in schools. So it's mostly

0:18:35.200,0:18:40.000

about education. The Catholic church has some power of

0:18:40.000,0:18:43.679

education in Poland. We have the Catholic religion

0:18:43.679,0:18:48.080

classes at schools. (EP): Do you have Catholic religion classes at all schools

0:18:48.080,0:18:52.160

in Poland?

(KB):Yes at all public schools we have

0:18:52.160,0:18:56.559

Catholic religion.

There is an option for other

0:18:56.559,0:18:59.360

religion classes as well, in case there is a

0:18:59.360,0:19:04.559

minority

that would request such lessons. So

0:19:04.559,0:19:08.480

there are some regions in Poland

where you have other religions

0:19:08.480,0:19:12.160

taught at schools as well. (EP): What would the major other ones be? (KB): Well other versions

0:19:12.160,0:19:17.120

of Christianity, so the Orthodox Christianity and the

0:19:17.120,0:19:20.640

Protestant Christianity. I'm not sure if there is

0:19:20.640,0:19:25.840

if there are any lessons of Judaism. (EP): In these schools where there is Catholic

0:19:25.840,0:19:31.120

religion taught is it taught that being LGBT is wrong?

0:19:31.120,0:19:35.760

(KB): Definitely yes, so that's the problem that actually according to conquer that

0:19:35.760,0:19:40.240

we need to have these Catholic religion classes at schools.

0:19:40.240,0:19:46.080

They are optional so the the pupils don't have to participate in

0:19:46.080,0:19:50.000

them, but there has always been a huge social pressure

0:19:50.000,0:19:54.320

to participate. And this is one of the things that we have been fighting, the

0:19:54.320,0:19:59.679

Polish Rationalist Association. So,

0:19:59.679,0:20:05.280

for example we opposed this habit that was there - that people who

0:20:05.280,0:20:08.799

didn't want to send their children to these classes would actually

0:20:08.799,0:20:13.280

have to opt out from religion. So we pointed out that you

0:20:13.280,0:20:17.200

need to opt IN if this is an optional subject

0:20:17.200,0:20:21.679

and not that it looks as if it's mandatory by the fact that they

0:20:21.679,0:20:25.360

subscribe your child automatically and you need to opt out. So

0:20:25.360,0:20:29.360

this has changed for the better (EP): And you managed to get it to be a proper

0:20:29.360,0:20:33.600

opt-in rather than opt-out. (KB):Yes but there are still probably some

0:20:33.600,0:20:37.600

schools where it doesn't work as it should

0:20:37.600,0:20:41.760

but in majority of schools it's changed in the last decade. There

0:20:41.760,0:20:46.480

has been a huge progress, also the classes of ethics has

0:20:46.480,0:20:52.799

been introduced as an alternative. But still the problem is that the

0:20:52.799,0:20:57.280

religion classes,
the subjects which are taught, are

0:20:57.280,0:21:03.120

completely decided by the Church.
The State or the Ministry of Education

0:21:03.120,0:21:06.159

or the
School principal have absolutely nothing

0:21:06.159,0:21:10.720

to say
about what's taught in these classes. At

0:21:10.720,0:21:15.280

the same time it's the State that's
paying the wages of these teachers.

0:21:15.280,0:21:21.360

But they are appointed by Bishops and
and the School Principal cannot even

0:21:21.360,0:21:25.280

fire them if they misbehave.
The Principal would need to ask the

0:21:25.280,0:21:28.720

Bishop to replace that teacher with
another teacher.

0:21:28.720,0:21:32.080

So this is really bad and yes there have
been incidents...

0:21:32.080,0:21:37.120

well in general the Catholic church
teaches of course that sex before

0:21:37.120,0:21:41.360

marriage is a sin,
that homosexuality is a sin, that

I see, so the idea is basically to try

LGBT rights groups and prevent them from..

however you can also see how this

tolerance to speak against

local councils,
to demonstrate for LGBT rights

and currently I know that the left-wing
party which is in the Parliament

is preparing another Bill
project for civil unions. It will be

the ninth time that this topic is raised
in the parliament. (EP):

Do you think it's likely
that this Bill will go through this time

given that the right-wing parties, the
united right are currently in power?

(KB): I don't think so but
it's very important actually to see how

other people will vote.
Because you see the problem is that when

there were also projects of the

And just as the Civic Platform was the

more sort of centrist parties that was

in power before. (KB):
Yes but they were very conservative;

this is something we forget because they
have changed

now as an opposition to Law and
Justice,

they have become much more tolerant much
more progressive.

(EP): What you're saying is that actually the
the greater conservatism

of the Law and Justice Party has
actually pushed

0:26:38.720,0:26:42.720
the Civic Platform the other way? (KB):Yes
that's definitely what happened

0:26:42.720,0:26:47.760
and because see now in this
presidential elections we had

0:26:47.760,0:26:51.679
the candidate from the Civic Platform
Rafael Chazkovsky,

0:26:51.679,0:26:55.600
whose one of the main points in the
agenda was the fight for the

LGBT rights, and the second one was the
reproduction rights of women. He didn't

0:27:01.279,0:27:05.200
have a long agenda for the elections.
These were the two main topics for him

0:27:05.200,0:27:09.120
and the general tolerance. And he was the
second candidate;

he was the one who in the second
round was against

0:27:12.720,0:27:16.880
Andrei Duda and he received around 49%
of

votes. So yes Andrei Duda was re-elected
but if you look at the numbers the

two candidates were so close to each
other. So it actually shows

that in a way the conservatism of
Law and Justice is somehow motivating

other people to become more progressive
and more tolerant. I really see this

and this process gives me hope. Although

We organise conferences,

(EP): But how far are your discussion forums, your conferences, your

Well the Darwin Days are very popular

and this is the only such initiative in Poland.

And we have hundreds of people who come to the lectures

and we have debates and we have videos that are available then

for people. And it is a huge impact.

So we are trying to create space

free thinking, for dialogue. This is

what we are trying to show - tolerance. We try to show what science

on several topics. In the past we

that fought for it so it's not just our credit but

we are very happy that this actually was accomplished.

(EP): That's great you seem to be having quite a lot of success so far

which is very encouraging. Just just one final question

Kaya. What do you think secularist organisations in different countries,

individuals in Poland who are simply unaware of the

certain reports or you know simply

their views on things
again because of language issues or

0:35:09.119,0:35:13.440
you know perhaps education issues
and I encouraged other organisations to

0:35:13.440,0:35:17.280
write to the Convention
simply so they have a very full picture

0:35:17.280,0:35:21.680
and they can know what's happening and
in a very practical efficient manner ask

0:35:21.680,0:35:26.000
Poland to
fix what needs to be fixed . (EP): Now I was

0:35:26.000,0:35:29.680
talking to
Kaya just now about some of the issues

0:35:29.680,0:35:33.119
facing Poland under the government of

0:35:33.119,0:35:38.160
the Law and Justice Party and
President Duda and the NSS submission

0:35:38.160,0:35:41.280
covered quite a lot of those issues. In
particular you were focusing

0:35:41.280,0:35:45.359
on the issue of education of children
specifically with

0:35:45.359,0:35:50.160
regard to the provision of LGBT teaching
and then Keith was focusing on issues of

child abuse in the Catholic church. So

what were your particular

points that you were trying to make in
this document?

(AM): Well the main point that I was trying to
make

And my big belief is that you know that

and what's his name? (AM): Adam Bodnar. (EP): And just looking forward
